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Get acquainted with the high level of the Finnish education and Innovation Pedagogy by Turku UAS

This training aims to guide the participants through a holistic development process to implement Innovation Pedagogy in their educational institution.

The intensive training is included in the development process as well as the implementation and monitoring of the change. It may include staff exchanges, site visits, strategy consulting and coaching.

The training begins with the topic of Introduction to Finland, the Finnish Educational System and Turku UAS and continues with the basics of the Innovation Pedagogy Framework: its main principles, cornerstones, innovation competencies, and assessment.

The participants will discuss the organizational roles and management, leadership in change management and a sustainable future. Each group generates a development plan for the institution, revised by Turku UAS' Innovation Pedagogy experts. As a result, the managers will be able to implement the organizational change and apply what they have learned at the training in real-life situations.

The training is conducted at the new EduCity campus, in Turku, Finland, by Innopeda expert trainers as well as other educational professionals. It can also be organized at the client's premises, in hybrid mode or entirely online.

Turku UAS provides access to "itslearning" LMS, an online learning environment for the duration of the course. All learning materials are provided in electronic format for easy access.

The training also includes workshops, collaborative work and visits to different learning environments (when conducted onsite).
